Taxes

Everyone has to pay them, but in Kentville we are committed to keeping the commercial rates competitively low.

Since 2012, Kentville has steadily reduced the commercial tax rate each year. Currently Kentville has the 5th lowest commercial rate in Nova Scotia.

Promotion

Kentville makes resources available to businesses and provides a robust variety of opportunities for free and subsidized promotion of your business.

The Town maintains an up to date website and business directory, a Facebook page with a growing audience of over 3500 people, a twitter account and a monthly e-newsletter. The Town also runs multiple subsidized joint advertising campaigns for businesses every year both in print and on radio with various media companies. Kentville believes in celebrating the successes of its businesses and telling the world how great they are.






Permits

All you need to know about the Permitting process.

Why is a Permit required?

A permit is necessary to make sure that the proposed development conforms with the requirements of the Land Use Bylaw. This permit can be obtained by filling out a development permit application, which is available on our website, supplying any relevant information about your project and sometimes paying a fee. If your project then requires a Building Permit, the Town officials will send your development permit and information on to our Building Inspectors for them to issue a building permit.

It is the property owner's responsibility to ensure permits are obtained.



Who can obtain a Development Permit?

- ↳ The property owner
- ↳ The contractor
- ↳ An authorized agent of the property owner
(that means you, tenants!)

When is a Permit required?

In the Town of Kentville a Development Permit is required for:

- Any New Construction
- Building an Addition to any building
- Structural/Plumbing Repairs
- Renovations over \$5,000
- Home Based Businesses
- Demolition
- Installation of a Pool
- Erection of a Sign
- Changing the Use of a Building
