



# Kentville Police Service

**Will be accepting Applications for their Auxiliary Policing Program**

**The BASIC REQUIREMENTS for the Auxiliary position are as follows:**

- Be a Canadian Citizen or permanent resident of Canada
- Be at least 19 years of age
- Have a Valid Drivers License
- Must be of good moral character and are mentally and physically able to perform the duties of the Auxiliary position
- Have completed Standard First Aid and CPR
- Must agree to abide by the directives of the Kentville Police Service
- Not have been convicted of a criminal offence for which a pardon has not been granted
- Will be required to successfully complete all training as required by the Kentville Police Service

The Kentville Police Service receives its mandate from the Nova Scotia Police Act, Auxiliary Police Officers, Section 91 (<http://nslegislature.ca/legc/statutes/police.pdf>).

The Kentville Police Service Auxiliary was formed in October 2000 as an assistance to the regular members of the Police Service. Auxiliary Constables assist with general duties on a volunteer basis such as patrolling with the regular members, assisting with community events such as Remembrance Day Parade, Apple Blossom Festival, Crime Prevention Initiatives and many other community events.

## **Application Process:**

Applications can be delivered on or before **April 28, 2017** to the Kentville Police Service, 80 River Street, Kentville, NS, B4N 1G9. **Attention Chief of Police**

Applicants will be required to undergo the following:

1. Interview Process
2. Aptitude and Psychological testing
3. Background investigation
