## Your Opportunity:

Reporting to the Supervisor of Facility Operations, the Arena/Small Equipment Operator will be responsible for arena operations (ice making/removal, ice resurfacing \& maintenance, custodial duties, \& snow removal). In addition, the Arena 1/Small Equipment Operator position will be responsible for refrigeration plant monitoring. In the arena's off season, duties will include tractor/large mower operation, assisting in upkeep of parks
and play areas, including our trails and nature reserves (cleanups, minor repairs, aiding in landscaping projects, etc.), and event support as required.

The role should appeal to an individual that takes pride in their work and enjoys being outside and around people in a fast paced, recreational facility environment. Successful applicants will have experience in arena operations, which would include ice resurfacing operations, Zamboni maintenance, ice maintenance (edging, patching, building, painting), small equipment operations (mid-sized tractors \& attachments) and general park space upkeep, such as garbage removal.

Conditions will include working both as part of a team, and independently.

## Qualifications:
