The Kentville Canada Cup Organizing Committee is proud to bring you the third annual Kentville Canada Cup Mountain Bike Festival! We are the only national and international sanctioned mountain bike race in Nova Scotia and bring together riders of all ages and abilities, from all across Canada and beyond.

The Canada Cup is a long running national series organized by Cycling Canada in partnership from the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI) and is home to some of the finest mountain bike racing all across Canada. Elite and Junior racers at the Kentville Canada Cup will earn valuable UCI points helping them qualify for the highest level races in the world including World Cups and the Olympic Games.

A cross country, or "XC" race, like the one we will be hosting here in Kentville, attracts riders from all over North America and beyond. With racers, coaches, mechanics and hundreds of excited spectators, the event has a draw well into the thousands!

We intend to host not only a 2022 event but continue to host these races in the coming years, creating a lasting legacy of sport excellence, facility improvement, and an avenue for local riders to develop and excel to the national stage. *In fact we have already been granted the 2023 and 2024 Canadian Championships by Cycling Canada!*

Beyond just racing, look for lots of great festival style events during the week leading up to the main event. Group rides, outdoor recreation expo area, and skills clinics are just some of the great supporting events that will help to make our Canada Cup one to remember!

While racing is at the heart of our event, the Kentville Canada Cup is really about bringing the community together to celebrate living an active, healthy lifestyle and to showcase the amazing riding, scenery, and hospitality we have to offer here in Nova Scotia!



MOUNTAIN BIKE FESTIVAL AND RACES

ABOUT THE RACES

Riders of all ages and abilities have a place at our race with categories starting for kids as young as seven and several courses tailored to differing skill and fitness levels. We will be hosting cross country races at our Canada Cup in both the longer XC Olympic (XCO) format and the fast pace Short Track format. Riders compete in a mass start race and ride over varied terrain, mostly on natural technical and narrow trails. Races will take place on multiple days, and with practice times the whole event will run from Thursday to Monday.

Most of the riding will take place in the woods at The Gorge trails, off of Gladys Porter Drive, with the Short Tack running at Memorial Park, creating great visibility for the event to the general public. Memorial Park will also host the registration, participant camping, awards and other key portions of the event.

Major events like this always drive infrastructure improvements. Preparations for previous summers races included new trails, bridges, technical trail features, improved site signage and more. This summer will again see further investments into the trails and venue, taking what was already a great course and making it even more amazing!

SUPPORTING EVENTS

Beyond the racing there is plenty for riders and the public to get involved with at The Kentville Canada Cup!

Parade of Champions: The Kentville Canada Cup officially kicks off Friday evening with a bicycle parade for racers and the public around downtown Kentville, followed by a riders social and supper.

Space will be available at this event for sponsors and venders to set up displays and present to the public. Potential exhibits may include on site mechanics, food venders, bike and outdoor product demos, etc.

On Site Camping: A temporary campground will be set up at Memorial Park for racers, coaches, and event volunteers. Campfires, live music, and games make for a fun and memorable experience!

Guided Rides and Training Camps: Leading up to the race weekend we will offer several guided tours of the course to help racers dial in their lines and get acquainted with the event site. The general public is also welcome to attend these rides! Many teams and individual riders will travel to Kentville to train in the weeks and months in advance of the Kentville Canada Cup.
