The Leader in Rapid-Response Shelter Villages

We believe no one should go unsheltered when shelter can be built in a day. Pallet shelters are **cost-effective**, easy to set up, and have the capacity to serve people displaced by natural disaster or chronic homelessness. The shelters feature a **locking door**, windows, storage, personal climate control, and fire safety features. We partner with a service provider who arranges **on-site social services** for residents—a critical component in creating successful transitions to permanent housing.



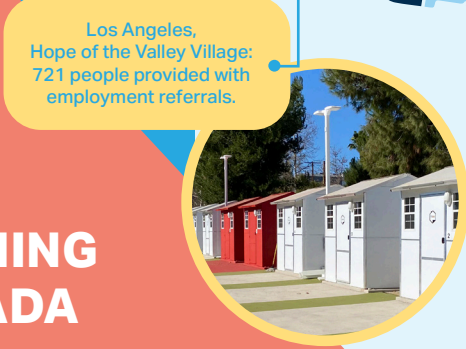
Everett, Washington:
Reduced resources needed for road and sidewalk cleanup by 66% and police calls for service in the areas have declined by 11% where transitional housing and services are available.

Vancouver, Washington:
Drop in calls for police by 25% and a 30% drop in officer-initiated visits within 500 ft of the village.



A rapid shelter in South Carolina went from email to opening in 72 days.

Dalles, Oregon:
62 people transitioned to permanent housing.



Los Angeles, Hope of the Valley Village:
721 people provided with employment referrals.

Denver neighborhoods hosting Safe Outdoor Space villages saw crime decrease by 19.2%.

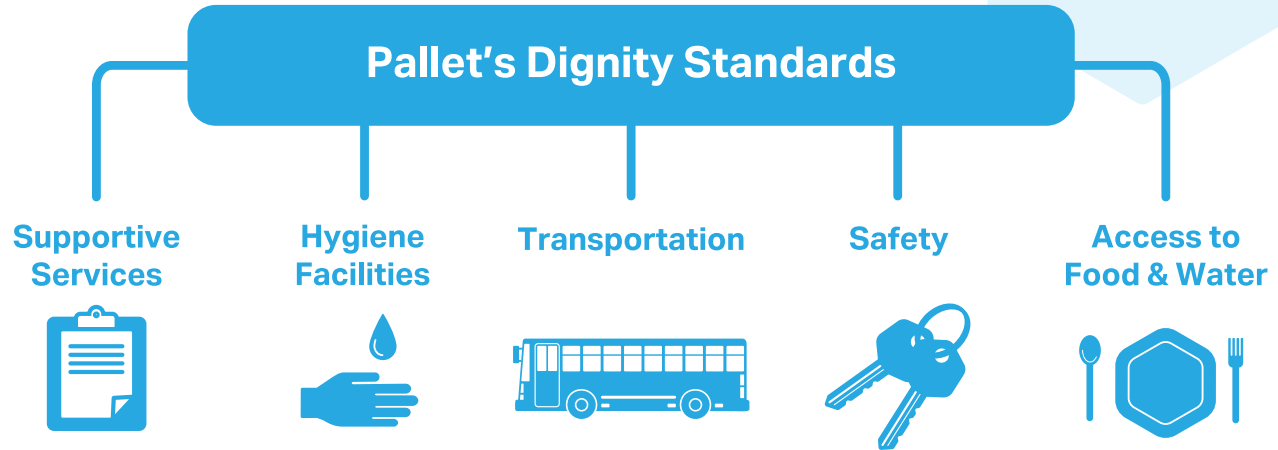
■ States where Pallet Shelter Villages are located

Villages are operated by community partners who collaborate with village residents to transition to permanent housing as quickly as possible. The services provided within the village are life-sustaining and foster a safe environment for all residents.

At Pallet, we believe in all people's inherent and absolute dignity. In partnership with village operators, Pallet has created a set of dignity standards guided by employees with lived experience. These standards are intended as a universal and irreducible requirement for the purchase and use of Pallet shelters.

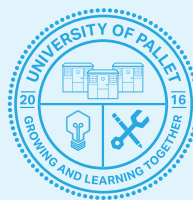
