The Mentoring Plus Program is accepting proposals through this Request for Proposal (RFP) from qualified designers to develop a unique and memorable brand for the program. The services will result in a new graphically designed image (logo) and phrase (tag line) to be used for business cards, letterhead, website, signage, and other marketing materials.

Program Overview:

Mentoring Plus is an initiative of Dalhousie University's College of Continuing Education that draws upon the skills and knowledge of retired people to help support young adults (16 and older) to explore and connect to career paths that relate to the 'Future of Work', by implementing Team Mentoring Initiatives. The program brings together collaborating partners (Town of New Glasgow, Truro and Kentville) that uses an intergenerational approach to achieve the common objective of increasing seniors' social inclusion.

Scope of Services:

Development of a brand concept, to include a message, tagline, and logo that shall be easily recognizable, marketable, and memorable.
