Your Opportunity:

Reporting to the Manager, Recreation Services and working very closely with the Kentville Parks and Recreation team, this position will plan and oversee the daily operations of summer opportunities in Kentville. This includes youth programs, pool programs and services, and community/partner organization programs and events. The Summer Recreation Manager will supervise summer staff, manage registration and scheduling, and plan and assist with community events. This is your chance to make summer for the Kentville community the best one yet!

Working as part of our team you will attend weekly department meetings and be asked to join other meetings as required, attend professional development opportunities, and support the daily operations of the Parks and Recreation Department. This opportunity will provide you with a look behind the scenes of what it takes to work in the field of community recreation and be exposed to the sector at the local, regional, and provincial levels. This position is right for you if you are hardworking, dedicated to positive impact, detail oriented, great with people, a team leader, and believe everyone has the right to play.

We are looking for someone who is:

- Enrolled in a recognized University or Community College in a recognized Recreation Management or Community Development program, with administration and programming experience (applicants with equivalent training & experience will also be considered);
- Enthusiastic, organized, and a motivated self-starter with strong creative problem-solving skills to adapt and pivot quickly in the moment;
- Proficient with Microsoft Software such as Word and Excel. Experience with program registration software (such as Univerus Rec) is an asset;
- Willing to learn and be a part of a dynamic team and experienced being placed in a position of leadership managing multiple teams working in different geographical locations.
- \mathbf{Y} Aware of your own privilege and how you are using it to help others;
- \mathbf{Y} Knowledgeable about the principles of community development and leisure education;
- A passionate believer and implementer of inclusive practices and about delivering thoughtful and impactful recreation programs;
- Willing to have fun and create playful opportunities which staff enjoy delivering and community enjoy participating in;
- \mathbf{Y} Flexible and available to work evenings and weekends as needed.

This position will run from May 15th until August 30th. Pending budget approval compensation for this 16-week contract is \$20 per hour based on approximately 35 hours/week, with some evenings and weekends as required.

Don't forget to highlight times where you have worked to pull a team together towards a shared goal, why you are interested in this opportunity, what skills you have that you love sharing and why we should pick you. We read a lot of resumes, so be creative!
