CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. and CAO Phillips reported that all members of Council were present (except Councilor Nola Folker-Hill), along with the Town's solicitor, the Town Clerk and himself. Senior staff members were also in attendance.

CASH-IN-LIEU OF PARKING 24 Webster Court

Mayor David Corkum noted that there was only one agenda item to be addressed during this Special Meeting of Council, and that was the request from the law firm – Nathanson, Seaman and Watts – located at 24 Webster Court. He stated that the expansion to their building would necessitate either additional on-site parking or would fall under the option of Cash-in-lieu of Parking Requirements.

that Council accepts \$1249.92 as cash-in-lieu for parking for the expansion of the property located at 24 Webster Court.
