About the job:

The Department of Engineering and Public Works is looking for a talented Engineering Technologist to be involved in the planning and design of diverse transportation infrastructure projects. In this position, day to day work includes working on concept planning, preliminary engineering and detailed design of roads, active transportation infrastructure, and a variety of other transportation projects.

With a focus on the Town of Kentville's commitment to safety and service, your primary responsibilities will include:

- Work with the Engineering and Public Works teams as a technical expert to deliver various transportation projects
- Draft plans using AutoCAD for municipal engineering projects (sewer, water, sidewalks, etc)
- Design and research support of capital projects
- Tendering and procurement support of capital projects
- Coordination with external agencies for capital projects (Nova Scotia Department of Public Works and Nova Scotia Environment approvals, Municipal easements, etc)
- Review Requests for Proposals and tender submissions
- Provide field inspections and municipal infrastructure maintenance.
