Re: Resolution- 2024/25 Withdrawal from Town of Kentville Sanitary Sewer Operating Reserve

The Town of Kentville Sanitary Sewer Fund's March 31, 2025 unaudited results indicate a deficit of \$117,214. This amount is subject to final auditor year-end review.

Municipalities are not allowed to carry a year-end deficit position. A year-end deficit position transfers into the following year as a charge against the Town of Kentville Sanitary Sewer operating budget. In addition, a year-end deficit position negatively affects the Town's financial condition indices for the fiscal year.

To mitigate, the Town can access Sanitary Sewer operating reserves to offset the final actual shortfall. The sanitary sewer operating reserve fund held \$395,721 as at March 31, 2024 with a March 31, 2025 balance projected at \$220,721 before deficit reduction and \$103,507 after a deficit reduction for 2024-2025.

### RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended to the Council Advisory Committee that in the event a Sanitary Sewer operating deficit persists, the final audited deficit value be withdrawn from the Town of Kentville Sanitary Sewer operating reserve.

RE: Funding Commitment – Climate Ready Plan

The Town has been presented with a funding opportunity to support the Climate Ready Plans and Process line item of the 2025-2026 operational budget.

Council, in November 2024, approved the submission of a funding application to the funding body to support a term staff position in the development of a Climate-Ready Plan for the Town of Kentville.

The funding body has conditionally offered \$70,000 to complete the project. The condition is that Council pass a further resolution committing its contribution of \$17,500 to the project and that resolution has to be received prior to June 30<sup>th</sup> or the offer will be rescinded.

Both the funding and expenditures are incorporated in the draft budget that was presented to Council.

#### Recommendation

Be it resolved that the Town of Kentville commit \$17,500 as its contribution to the development of a Climate-Ready for the Town of Kentville.
