- c. Fluoride (Added to Agenda at the request of Mayor Andrew Zebian)
  - Fluoridation of Town of Kentville drinking water was discontinued a year and a half ago.
  - The fluoride pump located at Mitchell Avenue failed, the pump was not replaced, and fluoride discontinued.
  - o Ceased full fluoridation in January of 2024.
  - o Pump cost to replace \$10,000 and \$25,000 for chemical.

## Points from Discussion

 Committee will be requesting information from Canadian Dental Association, Canadian Medical Association for information on the possible health risks of fluoride in municipal water, Pros and Cons. Mayor Andrew Zebian will contact these medical professionals and bring back the information to council and Kentville Water Commission Committee and possibly have these health professionals come and give a presentation on Fluoride.

Motion for Mayor Andrew Zebian to contact the Canadian Dental Association and Canadian Medical Association and have a representative from each attend a Special Meeting of Kentville Water Commission to speak about Fluoridation.
